Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. is a clinical research site in Austin, Texas and is committed to protecting online user privacy. When you visit the Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. website, you may review information about our current available studies, community events and resources, memory screenings, applying to participate in a study and you may access information about certain features of the Site (the "Services").

This privacy policy describes how the Site collects, uses, retains, disposes of and discloses Personally Identifiable Information ("PII") we collect online. In order to ensure your privacy, personally identifiable information (PII), Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. collects through our web site at www.sasraustin.com ("Site") is used only in the manner and for the purposes described in this Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. User Consent to Privacy Policy

Information Collection and Use

You may browse the Site without providing any PII, although your IP address will be collected.

If you complete our "Apply to Participate" form, we may collect your name, address, email address, phone number and age, as well as your interest in specific ongoing clinical research studies. We may also collect whether or not you would like to be contacted by Senior Adults Specialty Research to schedule a memory screening appointment. **These fields are all optional, you may choose to complete some, all or none of these fields.** You are also given the option to contact our site directly by phone, rather than completing the online form.

If you subscribe to our newsletter or updates about new studies, we collect your name and email address in order to provide you with the newsletter. If you contact us for information, we collect your name and email address so we can respond to you.

To summarize, Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. uses your PII to:

- Communicate with you;
- Reply to your request for information or comments;
- Monitor your usage of the Site;
- Send you information about Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc.

When we collect your email address or phone number, if you so indicate, your information will be added to our email newsletter mailing list for new study alerts and we will send you our email newsletter. Protection of Your Information

We value your trust in providing us your PII, thus we strive to use appropriate technical and organizational safeguards to protect PII from theft, other loss, misuse, and any unauthorized access, copying, collection, use, disclosure, alteration or destruction. We follow generally accepted standards to protect the PII submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it.
