Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. is a clinical research site in Austin, Texas and is committed to protecting online user privacy. When you visit the Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. website, you may review information about our current available studies, community events and resources, memory screenings, applying to participate in a study and you may access information about certain features of the Site (the "Services").

This privacy policy describes how the Site collects, uses, retains, disposes of and discloses Personally Identifiable Information ("PII") we collect online. In order to ensure your privacy, personally identifiable information (PII), Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. collects through our web site at www.sasraustin.com ("Site") is used only in the manner and for the purposes described in this Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc. Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy").

User Consent to Privacy Policy

By using this Site or by providing PII to Senior Adults Specialty Research, you accept and hereby consent to our collection, use, retention, and disclosure of your PII in accordance with the terms of this Privacy Policy. If you provide your email address, and indicate you would like to receive our site newsletter, you consent to receive emails from us. You may opt out as described below.

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time. Please check back periodically to check the most recent modification date to ensure that you are aware of any changes in our processing of your PII. Your continued use of the Site after any changes signifies your express consent to any such changes. If you do not agree to such changes, you must immediately stop using the Site. This Privacy Policy was last modified on October 22, 2021.

Information Collection and Use

You may browse the Site without providing any PII, although your IP address will be collected.

Information you supply to us:

If you complete our HIPAA-Compliant "Join a Clinical Trial" form, we will collect your name, address, email address and phone number, as well as your interest in specific ongoing clinical research studies. We may also collect whether or not you would like to be contacted by Senior Adults Specialty Research about future studies. You are also given the option to contact our site directly by phone, rather than completing the online form.

If you subscribe to our newsletter or updates about new studies, we collect your name and email address in order to provide you with the newsletter. If you contact us for information, we collect your name and email address so we can respond to you.

When we collect your email address or phone number, if you so indicate, your information will be added to our email newsletter mailing list for new study alerts and we will send you our email newsletter. You may unsubscribe from any of our email newsletters by clicking “unsubscribe” at the bottom of the email you receive from us or by contacting us by phone at 512-407-8628 or email at research@senioradults.net.

If you complete a HIPAA-compliant “Study Prescreening Form” on our website, we collect information you provide directly to us, such as:

- Demographic information, including your name, date of birth, email address, and telephone number;
- Health information, such as information about clinical trials in which you are interested in participating and information relevant to eligibility for those trials;
- Geographic information, including your country of residence;
- Health information, such as information related to a disease or medical condition;
- Correspondence you send to us; and
- Other information that you provide through the Services.

How We Use Your Information

We use and otherwise process each of the categories of information identified above for the following business purposes:

- *For clinical trial purposes.* We will use your information for, but not limited to, communicating with you in relation to clinical trial participation and determining whether you meet criteria for our clinical trial services. Information submitted to us will be registered into our database, unless otherwise requested by you. Providing information to us does not obligate you to participate in any study.
- *Communicate with you.* We may use your information to communicate with you, including; to send you information about clinical trial participation, send you marketing and promotional communications, and respond to your inquiries.
- *Analyze use of the Services.* We use the information to analyze the use of our Services, such as to improve the Services and ensure that content is presented in the most relevant and effective manner for you and your browser or device; to

administer the Services, including troubleshooting, data analytics, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes; and to keep the Services, Company, and users safe and secure.

- *Compliance with legal obligations.* We may use your information to comply with applicable laws and regulations and to protect or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims.
- *Any other purposes disclosed to you.* We may use your information for other purposes disclosed to you at the time we collect your information or with your consent.

Protection of Your Information

We value your trust in providing us your PII and PHI, thus we strive to use appropriate technical and organizational safeguards to protect PII and PHI from theft, other loss, misuse, and any unauthorized access, copying, collection, use, disclosure, alteration or destruction. We follow generally accepted standards to protect the PII and PHI submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it. No method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure, however. Therefore, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

We will retain PII or PHI for as long as necessary to provide our services. We will retain and use PII and PHI as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

We disclose your PII and non-PII to third party vendors who help us operate the Site. These third parties are contractually obligated to maintain the confidentiality of your PII consistent with the terms of this Policy and to comply with the applicable data protection laws. **We will never sell your information to an outside entity.**

We will disclose your information in response to valid legal process, for example, in response to a court order, a subpoena or other legal request for information, and/or to comply with applicable legal and regulatory reporting requirements. We also may disclose your information in response to a law enforcement agency's request or other request for information from the U.S. or other government entities, or where we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, or to verify or enforce compliance with the policies governing our products and/or services and with applicable laws, or as otherwise required or permitted by law or

consistent with legal requirements. In addition, we may transfer your information to an entity or individual that acquires, buys, or merges with Senior Adults Specialty Research, Inc., or our other business units.

Data Retention

We will retain the information you provide to the Site for as long as needed to provide you services, and as necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes, and enforce our agreements.

International Transfer of Your PII and Your Express Agreement
